Introduction

- NHRC has the mandate to promote and protect human rights in Nigeria.
- NHRC has the powers to monitor, investigate and report human rights violations in Nigeria.
- Since January 2024, NHRC in partnership with UNDP, OHCHR and GANHRI has produced monthly dashboard on human rights situation.
- The Dashboards contain data from complaints lodged at the NHRC 38 offices across Nigeria and human rights violations monitored through NHRC Human Rights Observatory.
- Children's rights

General Human Rights Situation

- Human rights complaints to the NHRC increased marginally in the month of June.
- Increased violence and killings in the middle belt
 Benue and Plateau.
- Emergence of a new terrorist group Mahmuda
- Killings arising from banditry and conflicts in the north central.
- Physical and Sexual Violence on Children
- The resurgence of Boko Haram related attacks in Borno State
- Increase in the killings of Military, Law enforcement and security agencies.


NHRC June 2025 Human Rights Complaints

 [An increase of 20% compared to May 2025]


Human Rights Complaints January - June 2025 Compared




June 2025 Complaints Across Geo-Political Zones




Consolidated January - June 2025 Human Rights Complaints Across Geo-Political Zones






Percentage Distribution of Complaints Across Geo-Political Zones – June 2025




Top 10 States for Human Rights Complaints June 2025




June 2025 Thematic Human Rights Complaints




Consolidated January - June 2025 Thematic Human Rights Complaints




January - June 2025 Thematic Human Rights Complaints




Complaints on Violation of Womens' Rights June 2025




Consolidated Complaints on Violation of Women's Rights January - June 2025






JUNE 2025 SEXUAL AND GENDER BASED VIOLENCE




SEXUAL AND GENDER BASED VIOLENCE JAN - JUNE 2025









June 2025 Violation of Children's Rights








Completed Investigations in June 2025


NHRC Concluded Complaints in June 2025



Top 5 States in Complaints Resolution - June 2025




Killings and Kidnappings June 2025




Killings increased by 75% and Kidnapping reduced by 40% respectively from May 2025

Human Rights Issues in June 2025

Suicides

- Police Inspector in Munya, Niger State
- Final Year student at Babcock University
- 23-year-old in Asaba

Violation of Children's' Rights

- Torture of 14-year-old student with hot iron over accusation of stealing N30,000
- 8-year-old girl defiled in Olodi Apapa, Lagos state by 45-year-old businessman.
- 50-year-old raped his 13-year-old daughter in Ijegun, Lagos state
- Teacher sexually assaulted two 8-year-old pupils in Ikotun, Alimosho, Lagos state
- 47 years old Man arrested for defiling neighbour's 13-year-old daughter in Kuje, Abuja
- 33 years old man arrested for sexually assaulting 9 months old in Potiskum, Yobe State

Mob action

- Youth burnt NDLEA in Lafiagi, Kwara state office over rising insiecueity and terrorist activity
- Angry student burnt Principal's house in Guma, Benue state over non-registration for an exam.

Human Rights Issues in June 2025

Extra-Judicial Killings

- 2 killed by stray bullets from Troops of Operation Hadin Kai in Chibok, Borno state
- 2 vigilantes accidentally killed in NAF airstrike targeting terrorists in Maru, Zamfara State


Vigilantes

- Vigilantes detain pregnant woman, two kids for 20 days in Anambra State
- Vigilante personnel allegedly beat father of two to death over dispute between his girlfriend and the deceased in Elele, Rivers State
- 12-year-old gunned down by Agunechemba vigilante in Onitsha South, Anambra State

Violations Against Persons with Disabilities

- Man and daughter denied access to Supermarket in Ilorin on account of his daughter's physical disabilities.
- Rape of an 18-year-old girl with disability in Lagos






