

Presentation of March 2024 Human Rights Dashboard

Nigeria faces multiples challenges in the protection and enjoyment of human rights for the citizens.

Insecurity expressed in terrorism, banditry, kidnapping and other activities of non-state actors have posed challenges to the enjoyment of human rights across Nigeria.

Economic, fiscal and monetary reforms introduced by the new administration have increased socio-economic inequalities

Nigeria continue to battle with multi-dimensional poverty impacting on the enjoyment of human rights

Mandate

- The NHRC is primarily charged with the promotion and protection of human rights in Nigeria.
- The NHRC Act of 2010 mandates the Commission to:
 - Publish and submit, from time to time, to the president, national assembly, judiciary, state and local governments, reports on the state of human rights promotion and protection in Nigeria;
 - Maintain a library, collect data and disseminate information and materials on human rights generally;
 - Promote an understanding of public discussions of human rights issues in Nigeria




NHRC March 2024 Human Rights Complaints

- Total Number of Complaints: 1580
 - Against State Actors 94
 - Domestic Violence 471
 - Violation of Children's' Rights 542
 - Against Non-State Actors 32
 - Against Private Sector Actors 36
 - ESCR 123
 - Right to life 71
 - Persons with disabilities 3
 - Others 157
 - Referred Complaints 24


March 2024 Complainst Across Geo-Political Zones




Top 10 States in Complaints - March 2024




Thematic Complaints Accross Geopolitical Zones




Comparison of February & March 2024 Human Rights Complaints




March 2024 Main Violators of Human Rights



Violation of Children Rights





Killing of 2 Policemen in Imo State.


NHRC condemns these heinous acts.
