#### Introduction

- NHRC has the mandate to promote and protect human rights in Nigeria.
- NHRC has the powers to monitor, investigate and report human rights violations in Nigeria.
- Since January 2024, NHRC in partnership with UNDP, OHCHR and GANHRI has produced monthly dashboard on human rights situation.
- The Dashboards contain data from complaints lodged at the NHRC 38 offices across Nigeria and human rights violations monitored through NHRC Human Rights Observatory.


## General Human Rights Situation

- Human rights complaints to the NHRC increased marginally in the month of March.
- Human Rights violations associated with Vigilantes.
- Extra-judicial killings by the Police and the Armed Forces
- The resurgence of Boko Haram related attacks
- Increase in the killings of Military, Law enforcement and security agencies.


## NHRC March 2025 Human Rights Complaints

  - An increase of 20% compared to February 2025


## Human Rights Complaints January - March 2025 Compared




#### March 2025 Complaints Across Geo-Political Zones




#### **Percentage Distribution Across Geo-Political Zones**






#### March 2025 Violation of Womens' Rights




#### **SEXUAL AND GENDER BASED VIOLENCE MAR. 2025**

## Killings and Kidnappings March 2025



#### Issues in Focus

#### Vigilantism and the right to life

- 16 killed in Uromi, Edo state
- 8 injured in Elele, Rivers state
- Delta State Anti-Cult Volunteer Corps member shoot and kill a 19-year-old auxiliary nurse in Oshimili North LGA

#### Killing of Military and Security Personnel

- 39 Deaths in March
- 12 soldiers from the MNJTF in Borno State by BH
- 2 Soldiers killed in Benue state by Herders

#### **Extra-judicial killings**

- Intoxicated Policeman killed a civilians in Niger state.
- Mentally ill Policeman killed 4 civilians in Cross River state.


#### **Attacks on Religious Communities**

- Abduction OF Catholic Priests:
  - Edo, Anambra and Imo
- Renowned Quran recitation winner abducted with his family in Katsina state.
- Killings:
  - Catholic Priest abducted and killed in Kaduna
  - Seminarian killed in Edo


## Abuse of Powers by Military and Law Enforcement

- Female Hawker and Motorcyclist killed in operations of FCT Task Force.
- Retired Naval Officer assault hotel staff in Abuja


#### **Top 10 States with Killings in March 2025**




#### **Percentage of Actors in Killings**




**Top 5 States with Kidnappings in March 2025**




**Percentage of Actors in Killings** 






